



Rangers' Update

With ash dieback disease taking a strong hold at Ham Hill, the rangers have started to remove any standing dead trees that pose a risk to people or property. Where possible, trees that have been affected by the disease will be left as standing dead wood, as it is an important habitat for insects, bats, fungi birds and many other species. All trees are checked for bat roost potential and bird nesting before being removed.

Our wonderful team of volunteers have continued their efforts maintaining the vegetation along path edges, keeping paths clear for visitors. The volunteers have also been pulling ragwort in the Plateau fields and Butchers' Hill, in preparation for our grazier to take the hay cut towards the end of Summer.

The rangers would like to say a big thank you to the team from RNAS Yeovilton, who came for a day of dry-stone walling. The group helped with the construction of the wall at the edge of Butchers' Hill, which the regular Monday walling volunteer team continue to make great progress with.

The rangers have taken a lot of care getting the site ready to welcome



families over the summer holidays. Ham Hill is a place to be shared and enjoyed by the community and we hope that you will take the same sense of pride in the park that the rangers do. Take only memories, leave nothing but footprints. Please enjoy a picnic on the hill in the warmer weather, but this is a reminder to please leave your BBQs at home. Grassland fires can spread quickly across a site and are often caused by disposable BBQs.











Wildlife

After a slow start, butterfly numbers in the park have steadily increased through late June and into July. It has been wonderful to see the **Marbled Whites** doing well. The grassland around the Rangers' Centre seems to have become a real hotspot for them. Over the coming month, look out for the **Clouded Yellow** – a migratory species that reaches our shore every year, with a 'bumper' year once a decade. The caterpillar of this beautiful golden-yellow butterfly favours clovers and **bird's-foot trefoil**, which grow steadily in our calcareous grasslands. Join us for our family-friendly Butterfly Walk on Friday 16th August to find out more about these fascinating insects. Please visit www.visitsouthsomerset.com for further details and booking.

At this time of year, the grasslands are also alive with sound. Grasshoppers and crickets can be heard chirring and chirping, also known as stridulating. Crickets sing by rubbing their wings together, but grasshoppers create sound by rubbing their hind legs against their wings. Both are well-camouflaged, and they are often easier to hear than they are to see!


'Uncovering Ham Hill's past for its future' project update



Ditch the Lawn

August is surely the best month to question the ecological madness that is "the lawn".

Lawns support little wildlife, demand precious water, synthetic feeds / herbicides and drain YOUR time and growing space.

So be like Elsa and Let. it. Go!



"No-dig gardening" comes into its own when reclaiming a lawn.

Lay thick cardboard directly over the area and cover with at least 5cm compost/well rotted manure. Pathways and edges can be laid out using gravel, mulch or chippings.

No-dig protects soil structure, ecosystems and nutrients. The cardboard kills what's left of your

August lawn, stunts weeds, and you can plant in the compost topping immediately!

As the cardboard rots down the compost merges with the soil beneath, leaving No-dig beds that require less watering and less weeding!

What can you plant in August? Lettuce, spring cabbages, radish, oriental leaves, spring onions, spinach, Japanese (overwintering) onions, chicory, kohlrabi, chard and turnips to name just a few.

Use your new space to interplant with edible flowers, fruit bushes and perennials to attract the pollinators. giving you a space that feeds your soul as well as your stomach.




