



This series is all about using small spaces to grow food to eat.

Green Wall Garden

Green Walls or "vertical gardens" are made up of planting pockets attached to a wall.

It's a fantastic way to increase your growing space and reflected heat from walls encourages earlier and/or longer crops.

There are several kits available to buy, but don't underestimate a simple repurposed capped gutter and wall fixings.

Shallow rooting herbs and salads are particularly suited to this type of growing, but my personal preference is for strawberries!

Strawberry "runners" can be planted out September - October. They are the small offshoot plants that look like little clumps of soil and roots with very few leaves! Have faith, planted out now, they will settle in over winter and be fruiting next year!

Runners are an economical way of buying strawberry plants but it's worth asking other gardeners who may be putting their strawberry patches to bed for winter (and often will have spare runners!).

As well as the iconic summer fruits, strawberry plants offer pretty flowers, delicate foliage and the subsequent runners soon soften the edges of the planters.

Keeping strawberries off the ground reduces slug damage and nets can be hung to protect fruit from birds and squirrels without the trip hazard to pets and children.

Lettuce and spinach are excellent companion plants for strawberries, perfectly suited to green wall growing and can also be sown now.





Rangers' Update





The Rangers had a busy summer season and as always, were supported by our fantastic army of volunteers. They have been busy cutting paths, including down Witcombe Valley and through Pit Wood, as well as continuing their work to control invasive species. The team have been pulling Wild Parsnip and Ragwort, and in the last month, have cleared the Northern Spur.

A contractor took the hay cut on the Plateau fields, after flowering had finished and the plants had set seed. The sheep have been taken off-site for now, to return later in the season to eat the fresh growth of grass that sprouts up after the hay cut and to tread wildflower seed into the ground. Following our annual grassland management programme where one field is left uncut, this year the Warren has not been cut, to provide habitat for invertebrates and cover for small mammals.

The wonderful walling volunteers continue to rebuild the dry stone wall at the edge of Butchers', overlooking Witcombe Valley. They have so far restored a section of 18 metres in length to full height, with the coping stones yet to go on.

The Ham Hill team are thrilled to announce that the park has been awarded the prestigious Green Flag Award for 2024. This award recognised the hard work of the Rangers and volunteers who care for these sites, ensuring they are enjoyed by visitors, local community and wild-life. A big thank you goes to the Friends of Ham Hill, for funding the entry cost this year.

Wildlife

Warmer weather finally arrived in August and we had some great wildlife sightings. There were plenty of butterflies and dragonflies on the wing. Late evening walkers were treated to a wonderful display of glow-worms amongst the Victorian Quarryscape. Not worms at all, the females of this beetle species will use bioluminescence to attract the males flying overhead.

At the end of July, we welcomed Key Stage 3 from Stanchester Academy for a BioBlitz. Despite the rain, the students found and identified an impressive number of invertebrates, including an abundance of Six-spot Burnet Moths – one of our beautiful day-flying moths, that pupate in a papery cocoon attached to grass stems.

As September sets in and the first whispers of autumn are in the air, flowers turn to fruit and our hedgerows bulge with berries. Look out for elderberries hanging in great clusters from elder trees. These berries are almost black and are a favourite amongst many species of bird – but very toxic to humans when consumed raw! Besides the blackberries, the sloes and the hawthorn berries, hazelnuts will also be falling to the ground. All of these are a valuable food source for small mammals, who will be looking for as much food as possible to build up fat reserves before winter takes hold.

'Uncovering Ham Hill's past for its future' project update

The rangers were very pleased to put their new tractor and digger to good use, and the machines have made a significant difference to their workload across the site. The team have continued to cut paths with the tractor and have made use of the digger for work to improve paths following an audit to provide accessible routes for the new Tramper (all terrain mobility vehicle), including placing boulders on the path up to the War Memorial, to create safer access for the Tramper. Likewise, work has started creating a new accessible path down to Deep Quarry.

Detailed designs for the new Visitor Centre are progressing and have reached RIBA stage 4, when precise technical plans are drawn up. The team are working with a landscape architect to ensure that the Visitor Centre fits seamlessly into its surroundings to provide a better experience for visitors. The interpretation design for the permanent exhibition is in the early design process and the team are really excited about how this will look.

From mosaic making to den building, ammonite art to axe throwing, we had a fantastic time at all our summer events – a big thank you to everyone who came along and took part! The Ham Hill Dog Show has been rescheduled for Sunday 15th September, due to August's hot weather. We look forward to welcoming everyone and meeting their furry friends! CADAS is the local astronomical society. We cover the area from Taunton across Somerset to the Ham villages and Yeovil. We meet on the 3rd Wednesday of the month at 7.30pm. The meetings are open to everyone.

The meeting on 18th September will start while it's still light with a "Show and Tell" by members of equipment or techniques they use for astronomy. This will be indoors fair or foul weather! After tea/coffee and cakes we'll set up to do an observing session on the field with telescopes and members guiding some naked eye observing if the weather permits. We hope to see some of the best summer objects. Saturn and the full moon will be rising in the east.

Our speaker at the October Meeting will be Adrian Dening (www.starsoversomerset.com) who will talk about his portable astronomical equipment.

Many people believe that astronomy requires complex and expensive equipment but you can enjoy the night sky with the naked eye, binoc-

ulars and take pictures with phone cameras. There are many objects or phenomena that can be seen, the most obvious being the Moon. There is much more to see. The Sun is very active and the Northern lights have been visible very recently. The planets are becoming more visible and Saturn in particular is observable in the evening sky. From a dark site the Milky Way will really stand out. These 2 images were taken with a standard camera with no additional or special equipment.


