





Rangers Update

This month we've been carrying out lots of brush cutting along visitor routes, cutting back woody materials at the edges of paths. We also cleared around facilities such as gates and dog bins and gave the bins a good clean! Sadly we had to take down several diseased ash trees in different locations due to ash dieback.

Ahead of the Remembrance Service on Sunday 10th November we gave the area around the war memorial some TLC.

We were joined this month by Yeovil College countryside students and hosted corporate team days for RNAS Yeovilton, the Hydrographic Office and teams from Somerset Council. The Dorset Dry Stone Walling Association ventured over the county border to hold their AGM at Ham Hill and also helped out with an afternoon of walling!

Wildlife

Light levels are low and much of nature is 'going to bed' for the winter, but you can still spot some splashes of colour here. The hot pink and bright orange fruits of the spindle trees are very noticeable. Spindle is a little tree with bendy, green-tinged branches that tend to droop. It was once used to make 'spindles' for holding and spinning wool.

Other flashes of colour that you could see are the electric blue of a jay's wing, or the bright red of a robin's breast. Carrion crows and rooks seem to 'dance' as they fly together in circles above Butcher's Field, making quite a racket! You can listen out for a variety of bird life in Horses Wood, and in Hedgecock Woods late in the day you might hear the atmospheric calls of tawny owls.

Our new Engagement Ranger Lucy is planning to put up a monthly sheet on the Rangers Office noticeboard, with nature highlights like these. Why not take a photo of the sheet?

'Uncovering Ham Hill's past for its future' project update

The rangers have been clearing around the lime kiln heritage feature and the nearby car park. We have improved access across the site for people with wheelchairs and trampers, starting with a site review involving Mobility South West. We flattened sections of path, lowering the gradient to make it easier for mobility aids, and installed boulders in places to make it clear which is the best route.

The volunteers have been helping with rampart clearance, modernising the steps that lead towards Stoke-sub-Hamdon, creating a (people-)perching bench for a dragonfly scrape in Witcome Valley, raking on the meadows to improve the grassland habitat, and carrying out lots of scrub clearing! The dry stone wallers press on making progress restoring the iconic hamstone walls.

Thank you to everyone including all of the groups that have worked up at Ham Hill this year.





December Sky guide - Moon Phases

Conjunctions

On the 5th December the Moon and Venus will very low in the South West. If you look for them after 5.00pm you may catch a glimpse of the Venus and a 20% lit Moon. Please wait until the Sun has set for your own safety.

On the 8thth December the Moon is close to Saturn. They will be visible all evening.

On the 13^{th} December the Moon is very close to the bright star called the Pleiades, it will be closest at around 5.30pm and on the 14^{th} December the Moon is close to Jupiter


On the 17th December the Moon is between Mars and the bright star Pollux. They will form a straight line. On the 18^{th} the Moon will pass in front of (occult) Mars. Mars will

disappear behind the bright edge (limb) of the Moon and re-appear on the dark edge. The event will star at 9.26am and will end at 10.17am.

On the 20th December the Moon is close to the bright star Regulus in Leo.

The winter Milky Way is well positioned and with binoculars will show many star clusters.

And now...Wrapping up this series all about using small spaces to grow food to eat...

Still sowing in December!

It's difficult to grow much outside in December without a greenhouse, so make use of your window sills.

You can sow onion seeds now in trays of seed compost. The seeds are small, but try to space them at 1cm intervals so they are easier to tease apart as they grow. Lightly cover with compost and keep moist, but not waterlogged. When the seedlings are a few inches tall, prick them out and transplant into modules of fresh compost. Once established, harden off and transplant seedlings into the garden 10-15cm apart.

The onions will be ready to harvest in late summer, when the leaves turn yellow and the stem bends over.

Window sills can also be used to grow herbs, sprouting beans and micro greens.

On dry days, check over your veggie patch & pots etc, keep on top of weeds and ensure perennials are protected.





Wet weather tasks are organising seeds, reordering favourites and planning next years growing! Which leaves me wishing you all a fruitful (and vegetable-full!) 2025.
